How & when did the two of you meet and then decide to start Atrocities?

We met in 1991 while living in Colorado.

A few years later we decided to begin creating a style of clothing which couldn't be found elsewhere for ourselves and our friends. This evolved into Atrocities, and our first mail-order catalogue was printed in 1994.

What goes into your clothing spiritually, artistically, materially, etc., and where doe:

the inspiration come from?

Inspiration for our clothing comes from a deep love for the gothic. We try to instill a sense of dark romance, classical beauty, shrouded mystery, and decadence into all of our items. The materials are lush, consisting of fabrics such as georgettes, laces, and of course, plenty of velvet!

What made you choose Salem, Ma as your headquarters, especially having come from so far away?

Coming from a western state where a building from 1940 is considered old, we can really appreciate the history Salem holds. It's wonderful to feel a sense of the past and to witness it in the centuries of architecture which line the town's streets. We also value the lesson of tolerance which Salem had to learn from the mistakes of its past.

Where does the future lie for Atrocities?

The answer to that really lies in the support we get from others. Atrocities has always been a labor of love for us, so we don't see it going away. We hope business will continue to grow to the point where we can both dedicate ourselves full-time to it, and perhaps open a shop where we can feature our wares, as well as those of our talented friends.
